Catherine Op de Beeck, driftwood as art



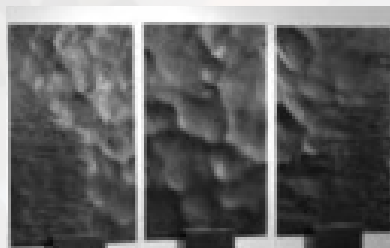
She created the library shelving, tables and light fixtures for the hotel.

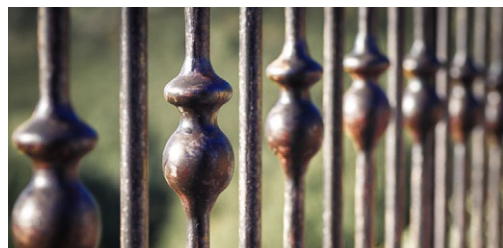
Antoine Perigot, photographer of lights
